## **Tuition fee**

#### €3,900 / year for all students

Scholarships covering the tuition fee and study expenses will be awarded annually to a limited number of non-EEA applicants. Only non-EEA students who apply before the 1 March 2024 deadline will be considered scholarship candidates.

There is a limited number of partial tuition fee waivers for EEA applicants who apply before 1 June 2024.


#### The main goal of PIONEER is...
