Policies to Improve Educational Outcomes for Students on Public Administration Master Level Programs in Georgia (Literature review)

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Abstract: The research provides an analysis of main challenges for the capacity building prosses on Higher Education Master level. Despite the Georgia has already being a member of the Bologna process for about seventeen years, there are a series of problems that still need to be addressed in order to provide the sustainable development in the country.
