Consider and characterize the concept of "governance" in the sense of: public, systemic, good, electronic (digital), network governance, etc., to achieve sustainability and innovativeness of the post-war reconstruction process.

Terminological definition of the concept of "governance". Characteristics of "governance" as:

- as a process of implementation of power and decision-making, government activity Government.
- Governance as public or systemic governance governance. Public governance as the interaction of markets, power hierarchies and networks.
- Governance in the narrow sense self-management based on network governance.

Such concepts as: good governance, sensitive governance, digital governance, etc., testify to attempts to systematically combine network governance and public governance.

In the conditions of the implementation of social governance, power is transformed from a hierarchical, bureaucratized superstructure into a kind of guiding shell for all governance actors. An example of such a transformation of power institutions is the functioning (as of 2022-2023) of the National Qualifications Agency of Ukraine.
