

Global Policy: Key Insights and Future Challenges for the Implementation of SDG

Abstract: Within the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals framework and based on the last three reports for each goal, we intend to research the lessons learned so far and discover the future challenges for implementation. The research question around which the study is conducted is: Are we ready to achieve all 17 SDGs worldwide? Recent reports indicate a significant improvement in SDG indicators, which reassures us that we are moving in the right direction, even if progress is uneven across different areas. We will try to establish future management challenges by monitoring the progress reached. The European member states are keen to go to each SDG level to develop transnational policies and methods. This study assumes that the steps taken within the EU are more substantial than those in other regions, but these efforts alone may not be sufficient to prevent a climate or health crisis. Different policy pathways should be developed, and more cohesive intergovernmental networks to support the SDG must be considered.
